Dear Parents,

This year our class will be participating in Lemonade Day, a free program that teaches youth in grades $4^{th} - 6^{th}$ how to start, own, and operate their own business- a lemonade stand.

Lemonade Day was started in Houston, TX in 2007 and has since expanded to over 60 cities nationwide with more than a million youth participating to date. Lemonade Day Fond du Lac Area will celebrate its 6^{th} year locally in 2020 and is a program of Envision Greater Fond du Lac. The program is free for all youth grades $4^{th} - 6^{th}$ thanks to the generous contributions of area sponsors. The objective of Lemonade Day is to teach children the entrepreneurial skills necessary to be successful in the future and become contributing members of their communities. They learn how to create a budget, set profit-making goals, serve customers, repay investors and give back to the community. For kids, one of the best parts is that after covering their expenses and paying back their investor, they can keep what they earn. We encourage them to spend some of their profit as a reward for their hard work, save some of their profit for a rainy day, and share some of their profit with the community that supported them.

- Help them enter their business results online to qualify for prizes
