WHAT IS LEMONADE DAY?

Lemonade Day is a fun, experiential program that teaches youth how to start, own and operate their very own business - a lemonade stand. Each year in participating cities, youth have the opportunity to experience entrepreneurship by setting up their business during their city's community-wide Lemonade Day. Since 2007, Lemonade Day has served over 1 million kids in over 80 communities.

WHAT IS THE IMPACT?

By teaching key analytical skills, financial literacy, and decision making, Lemonade Day fosters self-esteem and new mindsets that can propel youth to success. The impact of Lemonade Day is in giving your students the ability to make their own decisions and work through the process of starting a business. The money they make from their business is theirs to keep and we encourage them to “spend some, save some, and share some”. It’s good for them to spend some and reward themselves for their hard work, save some for a rainy day or to invest in their next business, and share some by giving back to the community that has supported them. Students will also be recognized for their hard work and results through the Entrepreneur of the Year Contest.

HOW IS IT TAUGHT?

The Lemonade Day lessons are available in two versions... a printed Entrepreneur Workbook, and the My Lemonade Day digital app. Depending on the city you are in, you may have access to different types of materials. When you register your student(s), you will receive your materials along with access to Teacher's Guides and additional resources to help you implement the program. Parents can also register students to participate in the program. There is no cost for My Lemonade Day or the workbooks in Lemonade Day licensed cities thanks to the generosity of many local sponsors. In a classroom setting, the lessons can be split up into multiple sessions depending on the amount of time available. (See the Teacher's Guides and Program Timelines for more information.)
